

PREK SCREENING AND KG REGISTRATION

WHO is eligible for PreK?

Children who will be four years old on or before September 1, 2020 are eligible to be screened for PreK. The child's legal guardian must reside in the Seneca Elementary School district.

WHEN is PreK Screening?

Registration for the 2020-2021 school year will be held on Friday, May 15, 2020 from 9:30 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. You must make an appointment by completing and returning the form below or calling the school office at 410-887-5945.

WHO is eligible for Kindergarten?

Children who will be five years old on or before September 1, 2020 are required to register for Kindergarten. **In the state of Maryland, Kindergarten is mandatory.** The child's legal guardian must reside in the Seneca Elementary School district. **Currently registered Seneca PreKindergarten students do not have to go through the registration process. They will automatically be placed in Kindergarten.**

WHEN is Kindergarten Registration?

Registration for the 2020-2021 school year will be held on Friday, May 22, 2020 from 9:30- 3:30 pm. You must make an appointment by completing and returning the form below or calling the school office at 410-887-5945. If you are unavailable to come on May 22, you may register any day Monday – Friday 10 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. AFTER the last day of school.
